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SP-TBI and SP-IT Faculty Mentored Start-up Programme

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SP-TBI and SP-IT jointly launched the programme called "Faculty Mentored Start-up Programme."

Under this programme, SP-TBI start-ups will be assigned, one faculty mentor. These mentors will be guiding the start-ups on the technology and will be called Technology Mentors.

Role of SP-TBI:

7. Scout Start-ups requiring assistance in the field of technology.
8. Share the information with faculty mentors.
9. Connect Mentors to Start-ups.
10. Quarterly allowance paid to mentors who are mentoring SP-TBI backed start-ups.
11. Follow progress report of start-ups.
12. Feedback from Mentors and Start-ups.

Role of SP-IT

3. Scout interested faculties.
4. Connect these faculties to SP-TBI.

Role of Mentors:

4. Monthly meeting with Start-ups for 1 year.
5. Quarterly report to be submitted to SP-TBI.
6. Advising and mentoring start-ups in the respective technology area.

Duration:

The period of SP-TBI mentoring will be 1 year for each start-up.
